

How to get to Strasbourg

△ There are several possible itineraries for each journey. The ones indicated below are the simplest, but you may find others that are more suitable depending on your departure time.

From Paris:

Take a high-speed train (TGV) from Gare de l'Est ($\approx 1h50$) or directly at the airport of CDG ($\approx 2h00$)

From Strasbourg Entzheim Airport:

Take a regional train (TER) to Strasbourg train station (10 min).

From EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg:

- a) Take bus 11 (direction Saint-Louis – Gare Ouest) to the Gare Ouest stop (≈ 10 min), then take a regional train (TER) to Strasbourg train station ($\approx 1h10$).
- b) Take a FlixBus to Strasbourg.

From Frankfurt Airport:

- a) Take the S-Bahn S8 or S9 train to Frankfurt Central Station (Frankfurt Main Hbf ; ≈ 10 min), then take a high-speed train to Strasbourg (1h50).
- b) If you fly with Lufthansa - you can reserve the « Lufthansa bus » until the train station of Strasbourg.

From Zurich Airport:

Take the S2 train to Zurich Central Station (Zurich HB; 10-15 min), then:

- Either take a high-speed train to Basel ($< 1h$) and then a regional train (TER) to Strasbourg (1h20)
- Or take a high-speed train to Mulhouse ($\approx 1h20$) and then a regional train (TER) to Strasbourg ($< 1h$)
